January 23, 2012, 6:30pm – 9:00pm

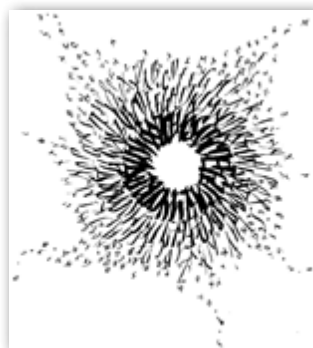
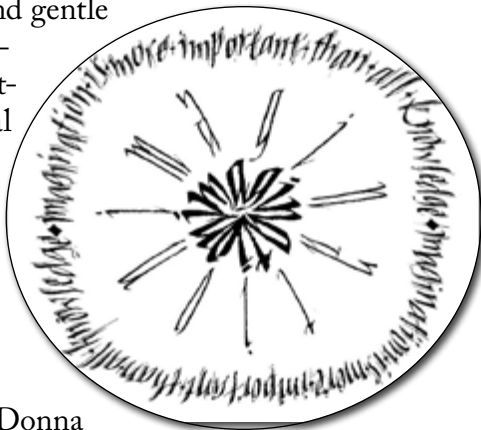
