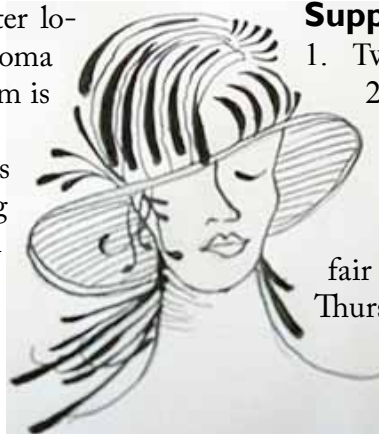

### Supplies List:

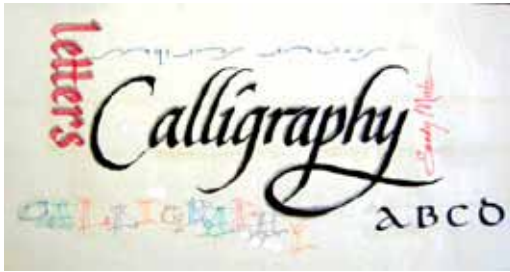
1. Two sharp pencils and a rubber band.

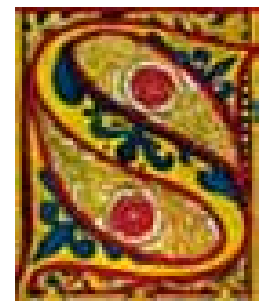
## WEB UPDATE
