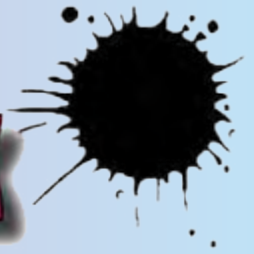

Sooner Scribes Fall Workshop

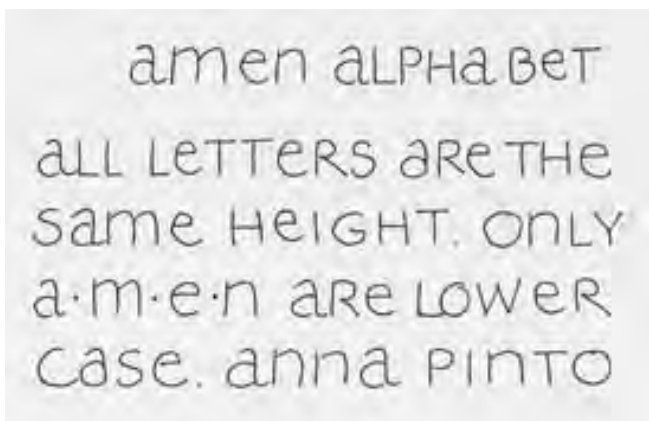
Love Your Letters - presented by Anna Pinto

September 21-22.

In this two day workshop, we will look at ways of using your own hand lettering to enliven your books, journals, greeting cards and other artwork. The first day will be spent working with three monoline* alphabets: **basic Roman capitals**, the **"amen" alphabet** (so called because the letters a, m, e & n are written in lower case while the rest of the alphabet is in caps), and a **simple angular italic**. The second day will address the practical applications and possibilities for using these hands. No calligraphic experience is necessary, *meaning no thicks and thins as in many calligraphic hands will be necessary.

The cost of the workshop is \$120 for Sooner Scribes and SWCC members; \$140 for non-members.
