Spring Workshop with Teri Martin

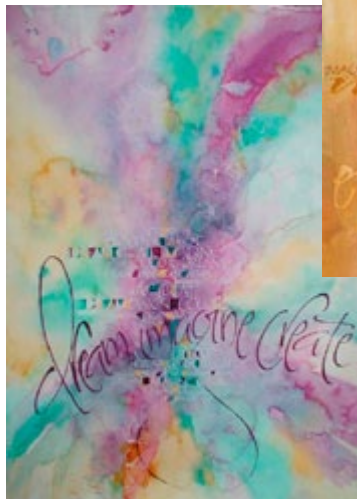
- What: Color & Calligraphic Painting with Teri Martin
