### SOONER SCRIBES CALLIGRAPHY GUILD IS ON ITS WAY TO DISSOLVING!

What does this mean?

- Sooner Scribes will continue to have meetings in August and September of this year.
- The current officers will continue to serve through 2017. The board will be offering workshops to our current paid members in order to deplete the money in our treasury and bring about the end of Sooner Scribes as of Nov., 2017.
- There will be a one-day workshop with Angie Vangalis on Saturday, September 17, 2016.
- Several more workshops with nationally known instructors will be offered through 2017.
- Current paid members of Sooner Scribes will be given priority to sign up for these workshops and will be given a **BIG** price break on each workshop offered after the June 4-5 workshop. After a two-week "members only" sign up period, we will give notice to the general public at a somewhat reduced price.
- All workshops will be held at the Scout Hut at St. David's Episcopal Church, 3333 N. Meridian Ave.
- Members' cost per workshop will be \$50. Non-members' cost will be \$100.
- The proposed workshops in 2017 will be with Linda Schneider, Doug Boyd and possibly, Carol Pallesen. The number of workshops depends on the actual cost involved in holding the workshop and the amount of money left in the treasury.
- All current paid members will receive a complimentary membership through 2017.
- Sooner Scribes is no longer accepting new members so **only** current members will receive the special breaks for these *excellent* calligraphic artists' workshops. This is truly a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to study with some of the greats at this *very* low rate. If the membership does not take advantage of this offer, Sooner Scribes will hold the workshop and the current board will attend.
- The Issues of Drops will no longer be available to the general public, but will be sent only to the current members.
- Sooner Scribes will maintain the PO Box, website, email and Facebook page

through November, 2017 so people can contact us once the workshops go public.

- Sooner Scribes will hold 2 meetings in 2017. The first will be in January to exchange Christmas Cards. Time and place to be announced. The second meeting will be in the fall of 2017. Time and place to be announced.
