The program will be "Making Marks and Pochoir" lead by Pat Lynn Moses.

MAKING MARKS and PO-CHOIR (French Stenciling). Pat Lynn Moses took a couple of wonderful classes at Ghost Ranch and wants to share some of the fun with the rest of the Scribes.

Louise Gruenwald taught a class

in which we dissected letters down into their basic components – marks! So we will be making some marks together, that will become a fun design – and you will know what it says whether anyone else does or not!

Anna Pinto shared her experience of collaborating on a book in which she translated her designs into stencils in order to be able to complete a series of the books. The stenciling technique is called Pochoir (a wonderful word that rolls off the tongue deliciously!) and was used in France in the 1920's to create fashion magazines. So we will make a stencil of the design which we will create with our marks – and then you can take your stencil home with you to create a series of as many as you want to ... on cards, in books, for stationary ... your imagination will take you on your journey of stenciling! The materials we will need are:

You will need to bring these supplies to the meeting.

- Sheets of sketching paper, (large and heavy weight)
- Pencil - regular #2 or carpenter's pencil for making broad strokes
- Wide Marker, parallel pen - something to make a broad mark
- Ruler - 6 inch is plenty
- Stencil material or transparency
- Xacto knife - to cut stencil
- Tube gouache - 2 or 3 colors
- Spray bottle of water
- Make-up sponges
- Small palette - 6-well is enough
- Masking tape

Pat Lynn will have all of the above, so only bring your own supplies if you choose to. there will be plenty for everyone to experience these fun processes.
